Harbach is Special Counsel to Director James Comey of the **Federal Bureau of Investigation**. Prior to joining the FBI, Harbach worked at the U.S. Department of Justice, serving as **Deputy Chief of the Criminal Division's Public Integrity Section**. In addition to his supervisory responsibilities, Harbach conducted some of the nation's **highest profile public corruption trials in recent years**, including the cases against former senator John Edwards and former Virginia governor Robert F. McDonnell.
